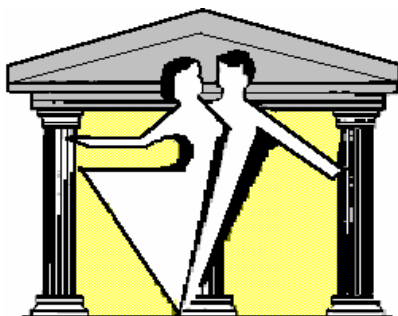

8. WORLD TRIAL COMPETITION AND LOG LADDER SECTIONS

Registration Starts at 7H00 SHARP for 9H00 START

Sections to be danced are as follows:

- Level 1 to Pre-Championships – Ballroom and Latin within all age categories (From 9H00 – 15H00)
- All Log Ladder Sections (from 16H30)
- Championship Sections (from 19H30)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Registration and Entries

- 1.1. All athletes must be registered members of FEDANSA for the current year.
- 1.2. All entries must be accompanied by a proof of payment slip. Please write your name and Province on the bank slip, ensure you bring your original proof of payment to registration, as it will be required to register.
- 1.3. Late entries and entries received without proof of deposit will NOT be accepted.
- 1.4. Entries may only be submitted on the official competition entry form.
- 1.5. Sections will be combined or cancelled if insufficient entries are received, in accordance with the rules.
- 1.6. Competitors/Athletes must note start times, sections will not be re-danced due to late arrivals.

2. Syllabus and Dress Code

- 2.1. NATIONAL SYLLABUS & DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
All members are urged to seek information from their PAB if necessary.
These are available from the organisers website plus will be available at the competition.

3. Strictly No Smoking Allowed

- 3.1 Smoking is strictly forbidden in all areas of the venue.

4. Cloth number

- 4.1 Temporary cloth numbers will be provided to all competitors at a refundable fee of R50.00
- 4.2 Dancers using unauthorized numbers will be disqualified.

5. General

- 5.1 By entering to compete in this event, the competitor/athlete/dancer agree to abide by FEDANSA National/Provincial rules and terms and conditions applicable and outlined in this document.. The FEDANSA National/Provincial rules are available for inspection.
- 5.2 The organizers of the event are NOT responsible for any injury or loss of property incurred by any competitor/athlete/dancer or spectator.
- 5.3 The stage area is reserved for Event Officials and Guests only.
- 5.4 Right of admission to the competition is strictly reserved.
- 5.5 No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the competition venue.
- 5.6 Catering facilities will be available.
